20-Hole Par 3 Challenge – Information and Local Rules

1. Challenge

The 20-Hole Par 3 Golf Challenge consists of a single round of golf to be played on Ria Bintan Golf Club's Ocean Course, holes 1 to 18 and Forest course, holes 1 and 2 to be held on 20th October 2018 (Saturday).

This challenge adopts Rules Ria Bintan Golf Club's local rules

Scoring System: 20 holes individual gross score

Golfers must hole out before moving to the next hole. No putter length gimme is given. Failure to hole-out, golfers will be disqualified.

In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined via a putting competition

2. Commencement of Play

Please report at the buggy allocated according to your tee box number, 15 minutes prior to shot gun start. There will be a siren to signal commencement of play.

3. Tee Box

There will be a specified tee box at each hole allocated for this Challenge. Men and ladies will tee off from the same tee boxes.

4. Novelty Holes

- Hole-In-One: All 20 holes*
- Nearest to Pin: All 20 holes

**Hole-In-One prize is worth Rp 10,000,000 per hole. Should there be more than 1 winner per hole, the winnings will be split equally by the number of winners for that hole subject to insurance deductibles if any*

5. Pace of Play

In the interest of all players in the tournament, players should play without delay and keep up with the group in front. Avoid slow play and observe marshal's instruction at all times.

6. Scorecards

All players must submit **gross** score only. Scorecards must be completed with signatures of both the marker and player and returned immediately upon completion of challenge.

7. Caddy

Caddy will be issued on twin-share basis per buggy.

8. Electronic Devices

Electronic distance-finder devices are permitted.

9. Organizer's Rights/ Disputes

All disputes shall be referred immediately to the Club's Official and Organizing Committee whose decision shall be deemed final.

10. Reliefs / Exceptions

Abnormal Ground Under Repair – All area marked with G.U.R (Ground Under Repair) signage or white lines are treated as Ground Under Repair. Free relief is allowed within (1) club length not nearer to the hole or use of designated drop area.

Embedded Ball – A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole.

Vertical Bunker Face – When a ball comes to a rest on a vertical bunker face, the golfer is entitled to free relief provided that the ball can be located. The player may take a free relief by dropping the ball outside the bunker within (2) club length, not nearer to the hole.

11. Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather preventing any player from completing a round, the organizing committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.

12. Dress Code

A best dressed contest will be held. Golfers are encouraged to dress up to the theme as follows:

- Blue and Green of RB20 Logo
- 1950s – 1970s Retro golf fashion

Prizes will be awarded for:

- Best Dressed Male (2 winners)
- Best Dressed Lady (2 winners)
- Best Dressed Flight (1 flight)
