18-Hole Golf Tournament - Information & Local Rules

1. Tournament

RB20 Golf Carnival 2018 consists of a single round of 18-hole game to be played at Ria Bintan Golf Club, Ocean course on 21st October 2018 (Sunday).

It shall be played on System 36, Stroke Play – Individual, in accordance with rules of golf approved by the R&A, USGA and the local rules of Ria Bintan Golf Club.

Calculation of System 36

Points will be accorded per hole as follows:

- 2 points for Gross Par or better.
- <u>1</u> point for Gross Bogey.
- **0** point will be given for Gross Double Bogey and above.
- 36 minus Total Accumulated Merit Points = Handicap of the day

Players will be divided into respective division following results from **handicap of the day** to determine winner for division categories as follows:

Division A: Handicap 1-18
Division B: Handicap 19-36

Member Division: OpenLadies Division: Open

Golfers must hole out before moving to the next hole. No putter length gimme is given. Failure to hole-out, golfers will be disqualified.

In the event of a tie, a count-back will be performed.

2. Commencement of Play

Please report at the buggy allocated according to your tee box number, 15 minutes prior to shot gun start. There will be a siren to signal commencement of play.

3. Tee Box

Men: White Tee Box Ladies: Red Tee Box

4. Novelty Holes:

Hole-In-One: Hole 9 & 17
Nearest to Pin: Hole 2 & 12
Nearest to Line: Hole 5
Longest Drive: Hole 13

Bulls-Eye: Hole 17

• Deerest Hole: Hole 3, 6, 8, 11, 14 and 18

5. Pace of Play

In the interest of all players in the tournament, players should play without delay and keep up with the group in front. Avoid slow play and observe marshal's instruction at all times.

6. Scorecards

All players must submit **gross** score only. Scorecards must be completed with signatures of both the marker and player and returned immediately upon completion of challenge.

7. Drop Areas

Drop area on the golf course is at Ocean course, holes 2, 9, 12 & 17. Use of drop zone is an option, otherwise rules of golf apply

8. Caddy

Caddy will be issued on twin-share basis per buggy.

9. Electronic Devices

Electronic distance-finder devices are permitted.

10. Organizer's Rights/ Disputes

All disputes shall be referred immediately to the Club's Official and Organizing Committee whose decision shall be deemed final.

11. Reliefs / Exceptions

Abnormal Ground Under Repair – All area marked with G.U.R (Ground Under Repair) signage or white lines are treated as Ground Under Repair. Free relief is allowed within (1) club length not nearer to the hole or use of designated drop area.

Embedded Ball – A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole.

Vertical Bunker Face – When a ball comes to a rest on a vertical bunker face, the golfer is entitled to free relief provided that the ball can be located. The player may take a free relief by dropping the ball outside the bunker within (2) club length, not nearer to the hole.

12. Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather preventing any player from completing a round, the organizing committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.

13. Dress Code

Golfers are encouraged to wear the RB20 polo tee shirt provided in the goodie bag
