### 18-Hole Par 3 Challenge – Information and Rules 8 October 2022 (Saturday)

#### 1. Challenge

The 18-Hole Par 3 Golf Challenge consists of a single round of golf to be played on Ria Bintan Golf Club's Ocean course, holes 1 to 18, holes 1 & 2 to be held on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2022 (Saturday).

**Scoring System: 18 holes individual gross score**

***Golfers must hole out before moving to the next hole. NO putter length gimme is allowed. Failure to hole-out will disqualify golfers.***

In the event of a tie, a count-back will be performed based on the total gross score for Ocean course, last 9 holes followed by last 6 hole, last 3 holes and last hole. If a winner still cannot be determined, a sudden death playoff will be held at Forest course, Hole 1.

The Organising Committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.

#### 2. Commencement of Play

Please report at the buggy allocated according to your tee box number, 15 minutes prior to shot gun start. There will be a siren to announce the commencement of play.

Competitors shall tee off at 1100 hrs (Bintan Time) on a Shotgun start for all tees. Late comers will be allowed to join in the game provided that scores are NOT recorded on the holes he/she had missed.

#### 3. Tee Box

There will be a specified tee box allocated for the challenge. Men will tee off from white and ladies from red tee boxes.

#### 4. Novelty Holes

- Hole-In-One: All 18 holes
- Nearest the Pin: All 18 holes
- Challenge the Deer: Ocean course, Hole 2

*\*Hole-In-One prize is given per hole. Should there be more than 1 winner per hole, the winnings will be split equally by the number of winners for that hole less any insurance deductibles if any*

#### 5. Pace of Play

In the interest of all, players should play without delay and keep up with the group in front. Avoid slow play and observe marshal's instruction at all times.

**6. Scorecards**

All players must submit gross score only. Scorecards must be completed with signatures of both the marker and player and returned immediately upon completion of challenge.

**7. Caddy**

Caddy will be issued on twin-share basis and allocated by the Club Management.

**8. Electronic Devices**

Electronic distance-finder devices are permitted.

**9. Reliefs / Exceptions**

Abnormal Ground Under Repair – All areas marked with G.U.R (Ground Under Repair) signage or white lines are treated as Ground Under Repair. Free relief within (1) club length not nearer to the hole or use of designated drop area.

Embedded Ball – A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole.

Drop Areas - Drop area on the golf course is at Ocean course, holes 2, 9, 12 & 17. Use of drop zone is an option, otherwise rules of golf apply.

**10. Inclement Weather**

In the event of inclement weather preventing any player from completing the round, the following will apply.

- Completed at least 17 holes, a bogey will be accorded for the remaining holes to determine a winner
- Completed between 9 to 16 holes, the best 9 holes' scores will be tabulated to determine a winner
- Completed less than 9 holes, prizes will be given out as lucky draw

**11. Organiser's Rights/ Disputes**

All disputes shall be referred immediately to the Club's Official and Organising Committee whose decision shall be deemed final. The Organising Committee shall reserve the right to amend the tournament rules as it deems fit from time to time.

The Organising Committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.

### 18-Hole Golf Tournament – Information and Rules 9 October 2022 (Sunday)

#### 1. Tournament

RB24 Golf Carnival 2022 – 18-Hole Golf Tournament consists of a single round of golf to be played on Ria Bintan Golf Club's Ocean course, holes 1 to 18. It shall be played on System 36, Stroke Play – Individual in accordance with rules of golf approved by the R&A, USGA and the local rules of Ria Bintan Golf Club.

***Golfers must hole out before moving to the next hole. NO putter length gimme is allowed. Failure to hole-out will disqualify golfers.***

Calculation of System 36 Points will be accorded per hole as follows:

- 2 points for Gross Par or better.
- 1 point for Gross Bogey.
- No point will be given for Gross Double Bogey and above.
- 36 – Total Accumulated Merit Points = Handicap of the day.

Players will be divided into respective divisions following results from handicap of the day to determine the winner for the respective divisions as follows:

- Men Division (Hcp 1 to 15): Champion and 1<sup>st</sup> Runner up
- Men Division (Hcp 16 to 36): Champion and 1<sup>st</sup> Runner up
- Ladies Division (Open): Champion and 1<sup>st</sup> Runner up
- Junior Division: Champion
- Overall Champion: Best Gross

In the event of a tie, a count-back will be performed based on the total gross score for Ocean course, last 9 holes followed by last 6 holes, last 3 holes then last hole. If a winner still cannot be determined, a sudden death playoff will be held at Ocean course, Hole 18

The Organising Committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.

#### 2. Commencement of Play

Please report at the buggy allocated according to your tee box number, 15 minutes prior to shot gun start. There will be a siren to announce the commencement of play.

Competitors shall tee off at 0800 hrs (Bintan Time) on a Shotgun start for all tees. Late comers will be allowed to join in the game provided that scores are NOT recorded on the holes he had missed.

#### 3. Tee Box

Men will tee off from white and ladies from red tee boxes.

#### 4. Novelty Holes

- Nearest to Pin: Holes 2 and 12
- Nearest to Line: Hole 3
- Longest Drive: Holes 5 and 14
- Deer-On: Holes 4, 6, 11 and 18
- Hole-in-One\*: Holes 2, 9, 12 and 17

*\*Hole-In-One prize is given per hole. Should there be more than 1 winner per hole, the winnings will be split equally by the number of winners for that hole less any insurance deductibles if any*

#### 5. Pace of Play

In the interest of all, players should play without delay and keep up with the group in front. Avoid slow play and observe marshal's instruction at all times.

#### 6. Scorecards

All players must submit **gross** score only. Scorecards must be completed with signatures of both the marker and player and returned immediately upon completion of challenge.

#### 7. Caddy

Caddy will be issued on twin-share basis and allocated by the Club Management.

#### 8. Electronic Devices

Electronic distance-finder devices are permitted.

#### 9. Reliefs / Exceptions

Abnormal Ground Under Repair – All areas marked with G.U.R (Ground Under Repair) signage or white lines are treated as Ground Under Repair. Free relief within (1) club length not nearer to the hole or use of designated drop area.

Embedded Ball – A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark on a general area may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole.

Drop Areas - Drop area on the golf course is at Ocean course, holes 2, 9, 12 & 17. Use of drop zone is an option, otherwise rules of golf apply.

#### 10. Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather preventing any player from completing the round, the following will apply.

- Completed at least 14 holes - A bogey will be accorded for the remaining holes to determine a winner
- Completed at least 9 holes – Final score will be based on a 9-hole game based on best scores played
- Completed 8 holes and below – Prizes will be given out during lucky draw

#### 11. Organiser's Rights/ Disputes

All disputes shall be referred immediately to the Club's Official and Organising Committee whose decision shall be deemed final. The Organising Committee shall reserve the right to amend the tournament rules as it deems fit from time to time.

The Organising Committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament, which shall be final.
